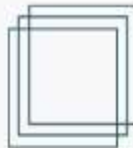
II. Literature review

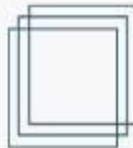

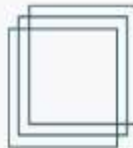

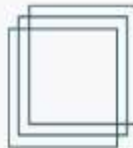

V. Conclusion

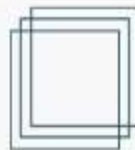
