**Keywords:** Military, political, competence, psychological, public, unit, pedagogical, personnel.

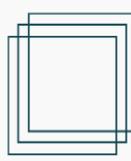
### **INTRODUCTION**


## **RESULTS AND DISCUSSION**


## **CONCLUSION**
