2006-2009 He works as the head of the adaptation center in the Aktobe Regional Migration Department. In 1980-2002, he worked as a chief accountant in the Shomanay District Education Department. In 1983, he received a degree in economics from Nokis State University.

Member of the Writers' Union of Kazakhstan since 2008.

Since 2009, the chairman of the "Kazakh and Ya" CB.

2010-2011 He works as the head of the Aktobe city language training center in the Department of Language Development.
